



Patient Portal Security Review - Two-step Authentication

Two-step Authentication will add a layer of security when you access your medical records through MyChart, our patient portal.

Two-step Authentication



IMPORTANT NOTE: As of June 8, 2025, the option to disable or not use Two-Step Authentication for MyChart will go away. It will be required of all patients from that date forward. Review the steps below for assistance.

- 1. Log into MyChart as usual by entering the username and password and click Sign in.
- 2. To proceed:
 - a. Click **Continue** to receive a text or email with a verification code.




3. On the next screen, verify the email and phone number or update if inaccurate.



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4. Select **email** or **text** to receive a one-time use code for this session.



5. Retrieve the code **from** the text or email and **enter it** into the field in MyChart.



6. Click Verify. Use MyChart Patient Portal as needed.

- **ADDITIONAL NOTE**: If using the Mobile App and Face ID is enabled on the device, there will not be a prompt for Two-step Authentication. Otherwise, set up should be similar. After the initial set up, an option will appear to remember the device. Use this to skip verification for every log in. **Log-ins:**
 - *Devices are remembered for 90 days on a web browser/PC and 999 days on the mobile app.
 - *Dates subject to change based on security measures.
